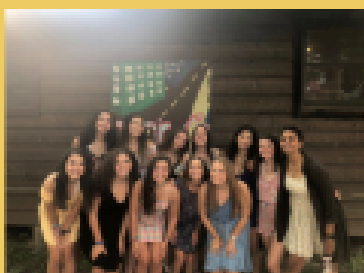
### Partnership
